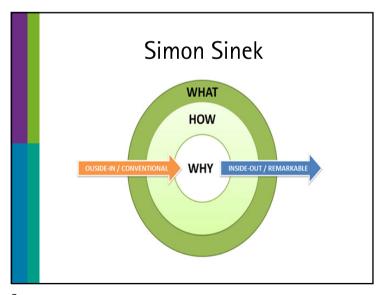
Eman Helal, one of 9 talented participants of the Arab Documentary Photography Programme:
